*Russians celebrate **Victory Day** on **May 9**. Victory Day in Russia marks the end of the Great Patriotic War in 1945. Victory Day is a national holiday in Russia.*

Many people attend a local military parade and watch the fireworks at night on Victory Day. The biggest parade is in Moscow's Red Square. People lay wreaths at the war memorial sites.

Russian people wear St. George ribbon and honor veterans. Veterans wear their medals and get flowers, usually red carnations. At home, families gather around a festive table and watch favorite Soviet films.

Remembrance Day

For nearly 100 years, on the morning of November 11 people have gathered at the Cenotaph in London and at war memorials around the country to lay wreaths of red poppies and stand silent for two minutes. The Queen and senior members of the royal family join political leaders and members of the armed forces. What are they commemorating? The ceremony is held at 11 am to remember all the people who have died in two World Wars and other conflicts. The bright red poppy is regarded as a symbol of Remembrance Day.
